The student leadership of the School of Pharmacy is in agreement that an increase in our supplemental fee is needed for the purposes as so detailed in the proposal submitted by Dean Audus. We support this increase in our supplemental fee with the stipulation that 10% of the new funds generated each year would be added to current private donations to fund scholarships for pharmacy students with financial hardships as determined by the dean's office.

We also support the increase in the supplemental fee with the understanding that the current fee will only be increased by a maximum annual rate of 4% for the next three years unless for some reason, funding support from the State of Kansas decreases catastrophically.

As the student leadership we feel this letter of agreement accurately depicts the feelings of the student body at large, as we provided a forum for Dean Audus to explain the reasons for the increase in the supplemental fee and for the students to address any concerns they might have.
