- <sup>1</sup> Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, about half of the credit hours students enrolled in were conducted via distance learning. In addition, the College of Liberal Arts & Sciences and the schools of Business, Engineering, Journalism, and Social Welfare suspended their credit/no-credit policy to allow students to elect to be graded on a credit/no credit basis in any class. The deadline to elect credit/no credit for Fall 2020 was also extended to April 30, 2021, so the data in this report does not reflect any changes due to credit/no credit elections made after the fall semester ended.
- <sup>2</sup> Excludes Applied English Center, Graduate Programs, Law, and all nondegree-seeking and graduate level students.
- <sup>3</sup> In July 2017 Urban Planning moved from the School of Architecture to the School of Public Affairs and Administration in Liberal Arts and Sciences. Architecture and Design dropped Planning from its name.
- <sup>4</sup> Includes Architectural Engineering.
- <sup>5</sup> Beginning Fall 2016, some courses in the School of Pharmacy use a new grading basis without grade points. Since these course grades are no longer included in the GPA calculation the resulting average GPA for Pharmacy undergraduates is lower.
- <sup>6</sup> The School of Professionals Studies was created in December 2019 and now houses all the degree programs based at the Edwards Campus. In Fall 2020, the school began offering classes and the following bachelor's degree programs were moved into the school: American Sign Language and Biotechnology from the College of Liberal Arts & Sciences and Information Technology from the School of Engineering.
