- ¹ Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, KU suspended in-person classes on March 11 and all classes for the remainder of the semester were conducted online. Additionally, students were allowed to request to be graded in any class on a credit/no credit basis and the School of Architecture and Design changed their default grading structure to Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory. The deadline for electing credit/no credit is December 18, 2020, so the data in this report does not reflect any changes due to credit/no credit elections made after the spring semester ended.

- ³ In July 2017 Urban Planning moved from the School of Architecture to the School of Public Affairs and Administration in Liberal Arts and Sciences. Architecture and Design dropped Planning from its name.

- ⁶ Beginning Fall 2016, some courses in the School of Pharmacy use a new grading basis without grade points. Since these course grades are no longer included in the GPA calculation the resulting average GPA for Pharmacy undergraduates is lower.
