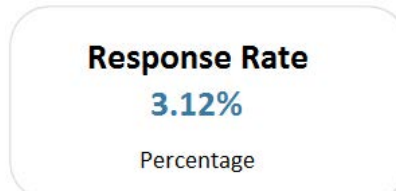


2016 KU Student Sexual Harassment Survey Results
